The 'Laboratoire d'Informatique de Grenoble' organizes the first French Brazilian spring school on Big Data and Smart Cities. This school is born from a collaboration between the Université Grenoble Alpes and the 'Instituto Federal de Educação, Ciência e Tecnologia Rio Grande do Norte'.
